Ali Qasim, 63, of Lubbock, Texas passed away May 8, 2022 after a long battle with colon cancer.

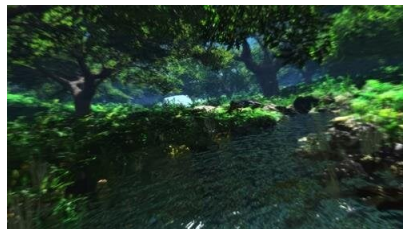

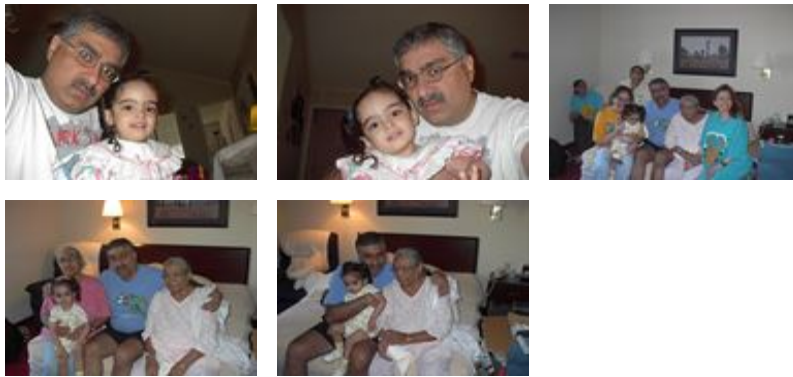
