Arthur Louis Robinson went to be with his Lord and Savior on Thursday, September 18, 2014. Born April 27, 1928 in Cleveland, Ohio, Art was the youngest of five children of Clarence and Helen (Luther) Robinson.

At the age of 17, Art joined the U.S. Marines. During his career with the Corps, he earned his high school diploma and furthered his education at every opportunity. He served his country during three wars, achieving the rank of Master Sergeant before retiring.

Art opened and operated Robinson's Magnavox in Orange, California, for 29 years. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Orange and a long-time member of the Orange Rotary Club, where he served as President and became a Paul Harris Fellow.

Art was preceded in death by his parents, his four siblings, and a precious young grandson, Arthur Robert Clodfelter.
