



## Barbara Ann Cox

October 19, 1942 - November 7, 2021

Barbara Ann Edwards Cox, 79, met her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ face to face on Sunday, November 7, 2021, in Lubbock. She was born October 19, 1942, the first child of Wayland and Betty Edwards in Los Angeles, Calif.

She grew up in Smyer and Lubbock, graduating from Monterey High School in 1961. She then attended Wayland Baptist College in Plainview for several years. She moved with her family to Artesia, N.M., where her father was a pastor. There she met and married Wesley Cox on Sept. 25, 1970.

Barbara worked most of her life as a bookkeeper and administrative assistant for various businesses and churches and retired as administrative assistant at The Lubbock Club. She returned to complete her college degree at Wayland's Lubbock Campus at age 63. She was a longtime member of Southcrest Baptist Church, where her father was the first pastor, and for several years played Mrs. Claus alongside her husband's Santa roles.

We will always remember her quiet grace and sweet smile. She loved and cared for her children and grandchildren and loved her Lord. We are grateful for the 79 years of life we enjoyed with her and look forward to a sweet reunion in Heaven one day.
