Billy was born March 7, 1925 in Albany to James and Willie Dorman. He moved to Lubbock in 1939, joined the Army in 1943 where he served as a parachutist during WWII. He received 2 Bronze Stars, a distinguished unit badge, good conduct medal, the purple heart, and the rank of Sergeant before being honorably discharged in 1946.

After his military career, he worked as a truck driver and mechanic for many years. He opened his own shop in 1978 where he worked until retirement at the age of 89. He enjoyed to fish, but his favorite past time was recounting his many adventures to all who had a willing ear.

Billy is survived by his daughters Colleen Levisay, Pam Hollis and his granddaughter Pamala Pollard whom he raised as his own.
