Bill Windham passed away Monday, June 17, 2024, at University Medical Center after an extended battle with cancer.

Bill was born on August 7, 1936 at home on a farm near Roscoe, Texas to Richard Goodlon "Buck" Windham and Bonnie Lucille Gideon and welcomed by his older sister Bonnie Joe. Bill's first job was candling eggs for a grocery store in Roscoe when he was twelve years old. He was a passionate Red Raider with season tickets to football and basketball for many years. Bill was a generous host and loved to entertain friends and family. He was a long-time member of St. Stephen's Episcopal Church.
