He was born November 3, 1947 in Blythe, California. He met his wife, Rita, in a little Pentecostal Church in Bloomington, CA at the age of 16. They married at the age of 18, November 15, 1965 in Perris, CA. He was drafted into the military in 1968. He served in the Army, Special Forces Air Cav Division, as a Vietnam Veteran. Their son, Dale Edward was born while he served in Vietnam.

They later moved to Lubbock, TX at the age of 27. Soon to own his own steel erection co. He began pastoring at the age of 35. He soon built his own church in 1984, where he was the pastor and founder for over 34 years, now known as World Harvest Christian Center.
