Bobby was born in Lubbock on April 14, 1960 to Juanita Jerrienne and William Samson Drum. He graduated from Coronado High School in 1978 and graduated from Texas Tech University “a Red Raider forever” with a Bachelor’s degree in finance, in 1989.

At the age of sixteen, Bobby developed a passion and dedication for coaching and playing softball. He traveled all over the US competing with elite girls, women’s, men’s, and co-ed softball teams. The Railbirds was Bobby’s predominant men’s team in which he both coached and played. Team Texas Softball, his youth and women’s teams including Lampe, Red, Blue, Green, Excellence, DJ’s, Blast, Baby Blasters, and Blasters have won countless state, national, and world titles. Bobby was inducted into the USSSA Hall of Fame as a manager in 2005. His profound influence on players and fellow coaches cannot be overstated, as evidenced by the hundreds of heartfelt accolades that have poured in. Bobby was committed to winning through hard work, while still having fun. He believed in the philosophy of “HEART, CLASS, MIND”. His gregarious and generous nature will be deeply missed. “Our big guy with an even bigger heart. “

A dedicated leader and mentor, Bobby was very involved within his beloved Lubbock community. He was a pivotal member of Lubbock Youth Softball for over 42 years. He was a director for USSSA softball for 30 plus years bringing hundreds of youth and adult tournaments to Lubbock. Bobby joined the Caprock AMBUCS business club in the early 90's and has been the tournament director for the Caprock Classic basketball tournament from 1994-2018.

Bobby married Sjanna Swinney in 2000 and they had daughter Sydni in 2005. In addition to his wife and daughter, Bobby is survived by his mom Jerrienne Drum, his sister Denese Drum. His memory will also be cherished by his aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces, and nephews.

Visitation for Bobby will be held from 6-8 p.m. on Wednesday, January 2 at Sanders Funeral Home. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. on Thursday, January 3rd at Lakeridge Methodist Church. 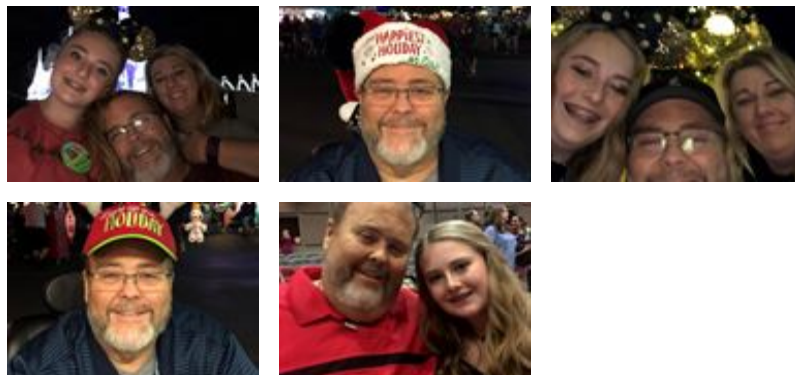
