Bob (B.G.) Wyatt, 83, passed away Sunday, November 17th, 2019.

Bob was born October 30, 1936 to Wylie and Frances (Harper) Wyatt in Phillips, Texas, the younger of two children. He graduated from Phillips High School in 1955. Bob was a proud Longhorn and graduated from the University of Texas at Austin with a Bachelor's of Science in Chemistry in 1959. He also attained his Master's of Business Administration in Management Information Systems from Texas Tech University School of Business.

Bob worked as a textile analytical chemist in the fiber research institute at Texas Tech University for 42 years. It was there that he met Caryl, the love of his life. They collaborated on several research projects and were granted patents for their work on bioremediating oil spills.
