



## Brittain Edward Hardman

March 13, 1938 - November 16, 2016

Funeral Mass for Brittain "Britt" Hardman, 78, of Lubbock will be held at 10:00 a.m., Monday, November 21, 2016 at St. John Neumann Catholic Church. Mr. Hardman passed away on November 16, 2016.

Brittain Edward was born March 13, 1938 in Seattle, Washington to Benedict and Marion Hardman. He and his mother moved to Las Cruces, NM, where she was a Professor of English at New Mexico A&M University (now New Mexico State University). He attended high school at the Abbey School in Canyon City, Colorado and received his Bachelors of History from New Mexico A&M University in 1959. He served in the U. S. Army as an Intelligence Officer receiving the rank of Captain from 1959-1965.

He married the love of his life, Dianne Elizabeth Brock on December 28, 1959. Britt was a former advertising executive and salesperson, retiring in 2001. He was a member of St. John Neumann Catholic Church where he served as a Eucharist Minister, Lector and Usher. He was a proud member of the Knights of Columbus where he achieved the rank of 3rd Degree.

Loved ones include his wife of 56 years; son, Harry Hardman and wife, Paula; daughter, Audrey Hartley and husband, John; daughter, Nancy Klemme; daughter, Patricia Coughlin and husband, Hale; nine grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

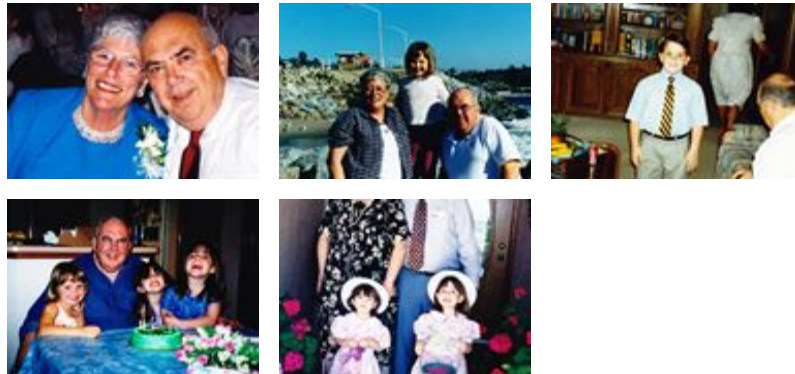
