Charlotte passed away November 15, 2020. She was born November 11, 1942 in Tipton, OK to Earl and Thelma Box. She graduated from Monterey High School and attended Texas Tech University. Charlotte married Richard Madigan on April 27, 1968. They were stationed across the US while Richard served as a helicopter pilot and officer in the United States Air Force. Charlotte served as the military wife and raised two daughters. Lt. Col. Richard Madigan passed away on May 24, 1985. Charlotte and the girls moved back to Lubbock in 1986. She called Lubbock home as she continued to raise her daughters and serve in multiple volunteer positions through the band programs in Evans Junior High and Monterey Band. When the grandkids arrived, she took on the role of spoiling them and coordinating Camp Mimi every summer.

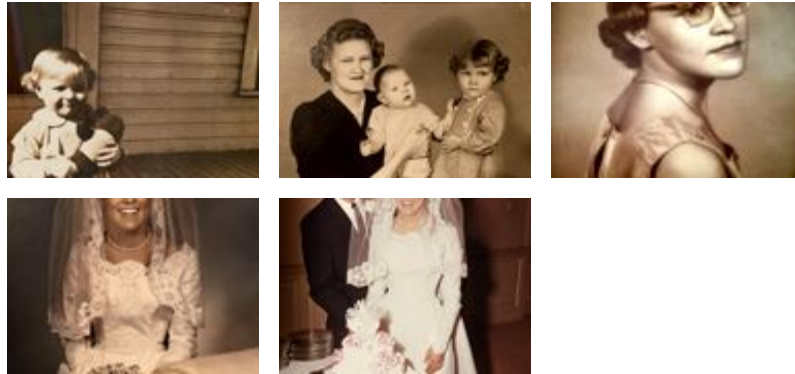
