Clinton Powell Adams was born in Lubbock County, Texas on September 23, 1929 and went to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday, December 20, 2024. He is preceded in death by his first wife, Kathryn (Lundberg), who was with child; a son, Alan Powell; his parents, Truey and Wilburn Adams; and his brother, Tommy Adams. He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Carol (Ewing), and four children: Mary Jan Beakley (John), Karen Jo Matsler (Jimmy), Richard Adams (Elisa Opheim), and Nancy Pfeil (Tom). 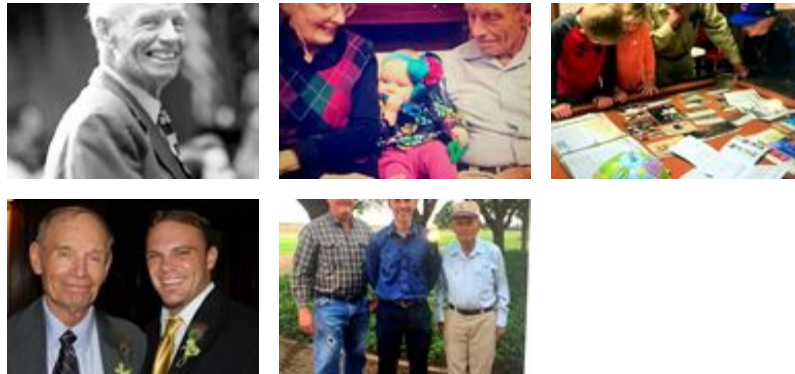
