Cynthia (Cindy) Phillips Finley, beloved wife, mother, and granny, passed away peacefully on January 30, 2025, at the age of 74. She lived there until she graduated high school, then started her freshman year at Texas Tech. She graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Home Economics and, later, a Master's Degree in Counseling. Cindy was very active in The American Council of the Blind of Texas for many years. She also was known for her great knowledge of resources for blind and visually impaired people.

Her guide dogs, who provided companionship and guidance, held a special place in her heart, symbolizing her resilience and independence. Cindy's kindness and compassion touched the lives of many, and her love for family and friends will be profoundly missed.

She is survived by her husband, Neil, her daughter, Heather Abel, and son-in-law, Tim Abel of Hale Center, and her wonderful grandson, Joseph William (Will) Abel of Hale Center.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Leldon and Alma Phillips and her brother, Mac Phillips.

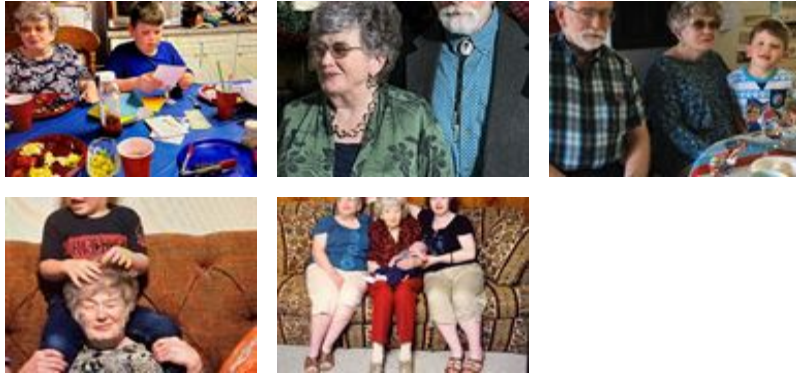
