



## Daniel Carrizalez

January 17, 1963 - March 9, 2023

Daniel "Danny" Carrizalez, 60, of Lubbock, Texas passed away on March 9th, 2023 in his hometown of Lubbock a week and a half after suffering a brain-stem stroke. Danny was born on January 17, 1963, in Lubbock, Texas to Jose Guadalupe Carrizalez and Antonia De Leon Carrizalez.

Danny was known for his strong work ethic and for bringing family together with his delicious food. His most recent job was at Joyland, where he worked for 6 years. According to the Deans, "he was a reliable, daily smiling face. When [the park] was open to the public, you would always find him working hard in the main concession, preparing the best made-to-order hamburgers, walking tacos, or any variety of French fries. During the 'off-hours,' Danny might be painting a ride, mowing grass, or helping keep Joyland the clean park everyone loved."

Danny also worked off and on at The Ranch House for approximately 30 years before that, until it closed. There were loyal customers that would eat there just to taste some of his home-cooking. He rooted for the Texas Longhorns and Pittsburgh Steelers. His favorite pastime was hanging out with his brothers, friends, and nephews/nieces out in the backyard. He was proud of his daughters, and would look forward to when they came to town to visit. His cookouts were legendary, and he would often invite the whole family over to enjoy bonding time together.

Danny was preceded in death by his father Jose Carrizalez; mother Antonia Carrizalez; brothers Robert Carrizalez; Anthony Carrizalez; Billy Carrizalez.
