David Allen Trout, 64, of Lubbock passed away November 6, 2014. He was born October 1, 1950 in El Paso, Texas. He graduated from UTEP with a degree in Music on Classical Guitar in 1982 and moved to Lubbock in 1999. David was a regular at several venues in Lubbock starting with the Chelsea's Street Pub in the mall, Grawdaddy's, and Skooners.

David won several awards in songwriting contests out of Nashville. His songs have been featured on the nationally syndicated Dr. Demento radio Show. He had an appearance on national T.V., when he wrote and recorded "The Television Evangelism Song" and was asked to be a guest on the Fox Network's "Late Show". David also made an appearance on "American's Funniest People" show.

David is survived by his mother, Esther Francis Trout; and brother, Philip Trout both of Lubbock.

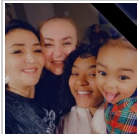
