Bertie Maydelle "Dell" Shannon Smith Spencer was born September 13, 1928, to her parents, Finis and Bertie (Coble) Shannon in Lamar County, Texas. She was the fourth of five children. She was predeceased by her parents, sister Hazel Shannon Cross, brother U.C."Bud" Shannon, sister Caron Shannon Holmes, brother Don Shannon, and three nephews, Jerry Carl Shannon, Dennis Wayne Shannon, and Frank Holmes. Of her family of origin, only Bud's wife, Ruth Shannon, of Paris, TX, survives.

Dell died peacefully in her sleep in her Lubbock home during the night September 28, 2023.
