Dorothy Ann Jacobs, age 94, of Lubbock and formerly of Winnsboro, Texas died Saturday, December 22, 2018, at Wilshire on 4th after a brief illness.

Dorothy was born October 12, 1924, in Corsicana, Texas to Gilbert Roxburgh and Etheline Bressie Roxburgh. She attended schools in Corsicana and graduated from Corsicana High School in 1941. Upon graduation, she moved to Houston to attend Massey Business School. In 1942 she went to work for Kyle Surgical Supply. On December 15, 1945, she married Charles G. Jacobs who had just returned from fighting overseas in World War II. In 1949 they moved to Lubbock. In 1952 they moved to Odessa, TX where they opened Jacobs Carpet Company. After selling their business in 1970, they moved to Winnsboro, TX to pursue a new career in ranching. The majority of her life was dedicated to serving others. In August of 2005, they moved back to Lubbock. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Lubbock.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles. She is survived by her brother, Tommy Roxburgh; son, Charles Jacobs, Jr. and wife Susan of Deer Park; daughter Carol Adcock and husband Woody of Lubbock; seven grandchildren, Paul Lackey, Sarah Doke, Deborah Larvin, Holly Lackey, David Jacobs, Carolyn Luna, and Julie Bessemer; and eleven great-grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held at 1:00 P.M., January 12, 2019, at Corley Funeral Home, in Corsicana, TX with inurnment following at Oakwood Cemetery.
