Dustin Jay Ferguson was born on December 24th, 1987 in Las Cruces New Mexico to Curtis and Susan Ferguson. He graduated high school from Friendship High in Wolfforth, Texas 2006. Dusty joined the Marine Corp June 2006 and was deployed to Iraq in 2008 for 3 months; He then went to Quantico Military Base in Virginia to finish his enlistment. After Discharge he married KellyAnne Carpenter and attended George Mason University. Dustin moved to Florida and transferred to Florida International University to finish his Bachelor's Degree in Information Technology. Dustin was an intern at Space X during his studies and remained with the company after graduation; he advanced to a systems administrator. Dustin lost his life on November 4th, 2015.

He is survived by his wife, KellyAnne; parents, Curtis and Cindy Ferguson; sisters, Kristi and Kattie Ferguson; brother, Isaac Watts; and 5 nieces and 3 nephews; plus many other family members, friends and Marine Corp brothers. He was preceded in death by his mother Susan Ferguson.
