Edith Cotton, 86, of Lubbock, Texas, passed away on July 15, 2023.

Edith was born September 18, 1936, in Quanah, Texas to Thomas and Isa Hawkins. She graduated from South Oak Cliff High School in 1955. 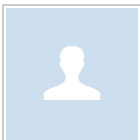

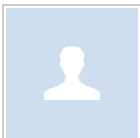

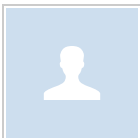
