Erline Heddins Evans, 96, of Lubbock passed away on Friday, February 22, 2013. Graveside services will be held Tuesday, February 26, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. at the Sanders Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. John Ballard officiating. Burial will follow at The City of Lubbock Cemetery. The family will receive friends at Sanders Funeral Home on Monday evening from 6-7:30 p.m. Erline was born to Thomas L. and Emma K. Heddins in Van Zandt County, Tx on November 24, 1916. The family moved to Lubbock in April of 1924 by train. Erline began and finished public school in Lubbock, then married R. D. Evans of near Shallowater on December 31, 1938. R. D. died on February of 1948 and Erline moved back to Lubbock to raise their three children. Erline retired from the City of Lubbock Purchasing Department in July of 1978 and has been a member of First Baptist Church of Lubbock for many years.
