



Eugene Collins Dycus

October 27, 1920 - October 21, 2013

On Monday, October 21, 2013 at the age of 92 years, 11 months, 21 days, Eugene Collins Dycus passed away. Gene was born on October 27, 1920 to Jesse Clemmons and Margaret Caroline (Collins) Dycus in Pushmatahaw County, Oklahoma. The family moved to Lorenzo, where Gene grew up and married Ida Nell Fulbright on August 1, 1942. They were married for 71 years. Gene served in the United States Army Air Force, stationed at Reece Air Force Base in Lubbock from 1942-1946. He went to work for Armstrong Mechanical Company and retired after 47 years.

Gene served as an Elder at the Pioneer Park Church of Christ for a number of years. He was also a member of Northside Church of Christ and a current member of the Parkway Drive Church of Christ.
