



## Frances Pettit

July 28, 1938 - June 8, 2017

Clara Frances Pettit, known for her cheerful smile and quiet demeanor, passed away June 8, 2017, after a lengthy illness.

Frances was born in Pampa on July 28, 1938, to A. J. and Opal Hill, the first of the couple's four children.

On May 29, 1957, she was married to Burle Pettit and, ironically, her death came just eight days after the couple had observed its 60th wedding anniversary.

After a stint as a stay-at home Mom, Frances launched her own business, cfp Dietary Consultants, which she owned and operated for 30 years. During that time, she served at least 22 facilities and enjoyed the largest dietary consulting firm in West Texas.

Frances is survived by her husband, sons Kevin of Waco, Kyle of Lubbock, Scott of Boerne and daughter-in-law Michelle Pettit of Boerne; six grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; and a brother, Charles of Bulverde. She was preceded in death by her parents, her step-mother, Roberta Hill Ford; a sister, Marilyn; and a brother, Alton.

Frances did her undergraduate work at the University of North Texas and graduate studies in food and nutrition at Texas Tech University.

She had served memberships in the Lubbock Women's Club, the Lubbock Club, Lubbock Country Club, and was an active member of First Christian Church and the Upper Room Sunday school class.

Her professional memberships included the American Dietary Association, the

Texas Dietary Association and the Lubbock Dietary Association.

The family will receive friends from 5:00-6:30 PM, Sunday, June 11, 2017 at Sanders Funeral Home. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 AM Monday, June 12, 2017, First Christian Church, presided by Rev.
