Frank Drury of Lubbock, TX went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday March 18, 2013 at the age of 63.

Frank was born on August 28, 1949 in Eckman, WV to James and Elizabeth "Leisel" Drury. At the age of 5 his family moved to Lubbock. He graduated from Lubbock High School in 1968. He worked for Payless Shoesource as an area manager for Lubbock and El Paso; and RSI Corporation as their Executive VP for Sales and Marketing. After 17 years with RSI he retired and spent his days at home with his Chihuahuas.

Frank married the love of his life, Sandy Davidson Drury, on November 9, 1974, and then on July 31, 1985 he was given his pride and joy, daughter Elizabeth Brianne Drury.

Frank was preceded in death by his father, James in 1995, and mother, Leisel in 2007.
