Frank Soliz, 74, formerly from Iowa, Louisiana. He passed away January 10, 2022. Frank was born April 11, 1947 in Ecletto, TX to Juan Soliz and Jacinta Soliz. He graduated from Plainview High School in 1966 and received his associates degree from TSTI. Frank served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Era. He was assigned to the 83rd Engineering Battalion, Fort Riley, Kansas-5th US Army, where he was Honorably Discharged. During his honorable service, Frank was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Aircraft Crewman Badge, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal with Device-60, and Two Overseas Service Bars. After his honorable discharged Frank became a pilot, an airplane mechanic, and crop duster pilot. He married Mary Arteaga on April 17, 1970.

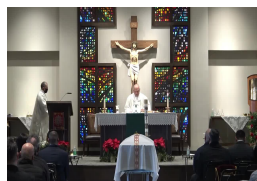

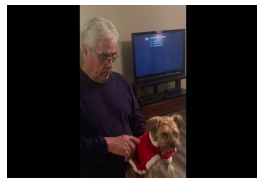
