



Gene Harold Adams

Gene H. Adams passed away quietly on April 15, 2024 after a long illness. He was born on October 14, 1934 in Vineland, N.J. to Myrtle Reed Adams and Harold Adams.

Gene was the oldest of five brothers so he was followed around by four little brothers, playing baseball, running track and riding bikes. All five, in time, volunteered for the military.

Gene joined the military in January 1954 for a three year stint. He was in the Guided Missile Corp, Redstone arsenal in Huntsville, Alabama and Monmouth, N.J. He was discharged in January 1957 with good conduct medal and National Defense Service Medal.

Soon after going home to Vineland his family put him on a bus to Colorado School of Mines in Golden, CO. He graduated as a chemical engineer and worked for Amoco Oil in Houston and Brownfield, Texas for many years. He was a member of Mensa, a genius, but a very down to earth guy. He spoke German and Spanish fluently.

Gene was a kind a generous man. He donated to many, many charities over his lifetime. He loved animals and rescued many.

Gene was a runner from his school days on. He ran 90,000 miles until his health started declining at 87 years old. He ran many marathons for charity and has many trophies to show for it. Also an avid pool player for which he won many trophies. He was a very unique man.

Preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Ted and Bob.

Survived by two brothers, Harold Adams of Iowa Park, Texas and Jack Adams of Vineland, N.J. and best friend forever, Nancy McCuthcheon.
