Reverend George Albert Roney, 69, of Lubbock, died September 3, 2021, at his residence. Rosary will be recited at 7:00 p.m. at Holy Spirit Catholic Church in Lubbock on Thursday, September 16, 2021. Mass will be celebrated at 11:00 a.m. at Holy Spirit on Friday, September 17, 2021. with Bishop Robert M. Coerver officiating. Homilist will be Father Jim McCartney. Inurnment will be at a later date.

George was born June 26, 1952, in Pampa, Texas. He was ordained a priest on June 3, 1978, and served a number of parishes within the Lubbock Diocese.
