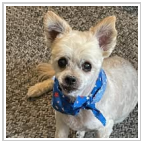

I will never tire of looking for you 💕💕*

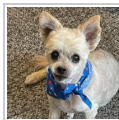

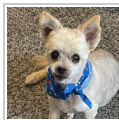

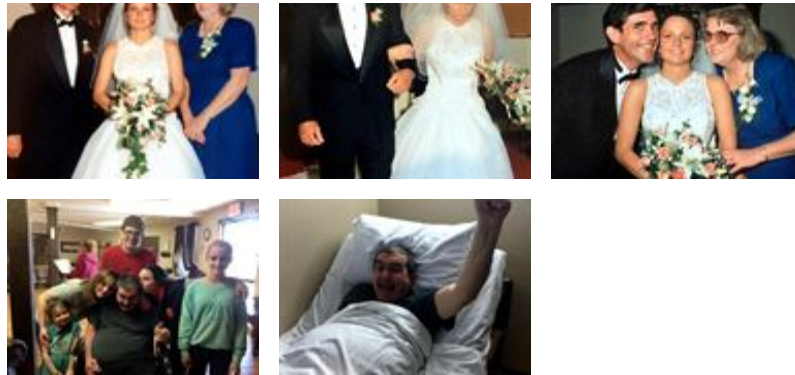
