Gordon, I have and will always find strength and peace in knowing that my Dad, like yours has now, has reached up...and touched the face of God...

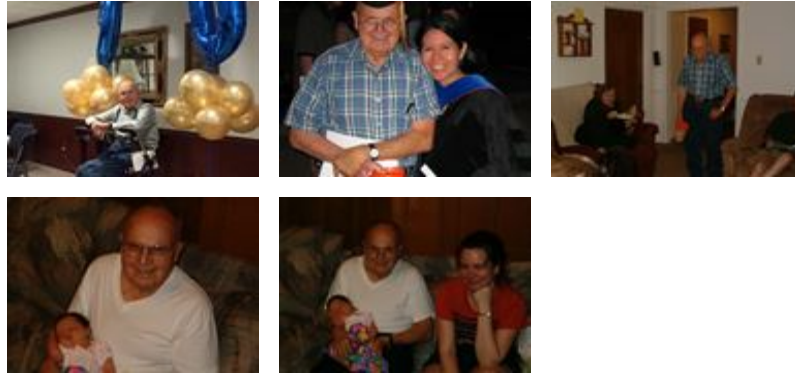
