On August 24, 1947, the Lord blessed Cecil H. and Pauline M. (English) Scott with a beautiful red-headed baby girl. On February 27, 2015, Jan returned to the arms of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Jan was born and raised in Slaton, Texas and graduated from Slaton High School in 1965 and was a proud and honored Slaton Tigerette. She then attended the Southwestern State Pharmacy School in Weatherford, OK graduating with a BS degree in Pharmacy in 1970. Jan worked as a pharmacist for the State of Texas in Tarrant County as well as several local pharmacies during her distinguished career. Being a pharmacist and caring for the medical needs of others was a passion of hers and by sharing her abundance of knowledge she inspired other women to enter the profession.

Jan married James (Jim) Morton on December 2, 1978 in Hurst, Texas where they resided for many years. They returned to Slaton upon Jan's semi-retirement to care for her elderly parents and to serve her church and community.
