John Thomas "Jay" Leeson, V, 44, of Lubbock, Texas passed away September 28, 2023.

Jay was born March 5, 1979 in Plainview , TX to John Leeson, IV and Barbara Leeson. He grew up in Abernathy, TX, then studied journalism at Texas Tech University and theology at Asbury Theological Seminary. He merged these two passions in his journalistic endeavors in writing, radio and cartooning.

Jay had a caring heart and loved West Texas. He was passionate about speaking up for the marginalized and used his theological background to be a prophetic voice in the public sphere. In recent years this took the form of advocating for rural populations of Texas. He often signed off communications with the phrase "Hale County Forever." Jay was an award-winning cartoonist and journalist whose work appeared in numerous publications locally, throughout the state and nationwide. He was also named a Colonel by the state of Kentucky for his work supporting locally-owned businesses. We will all miss his creativity, intellect and political courage.

Jay was a devoted father who adored his children, and a beloved son and brother. He was a friend to many people from all walks of life.

Jay's loved ones include his daughter Grace; sons Jack, Sam and Charlie;

beloved mother Barbara Leeson of Lubbock; father and step-mother John and Leslie Leeson of Wagoner, OK; brother Michael (Emma) Leeson of Madison, WI; sister Whitney (Jevon) Cheney of Ohio; brother Tucker Leeson of Lubbock; numerous nieces and nephews; Charity Leeson of Lubbock; and the Nick White family of Abilene.
