Jill Norman, 64, of Lubbock, Texas passed away peacefully in her sleep on December 23, 2023. Jill was born on March 13, 1959 in Slaton, Texas, the daughter of the late Noel Norman (d. 1993) and the late Sherry Custer Norman (d. 1994).

After graduating from San Angelo Central High School, Jill began her career in the mortgage industry before transitioning into the legal sector as a legal assistant. Following a successful career with some of Lubbock's most prominent attorneys, Jill retired in 2020. 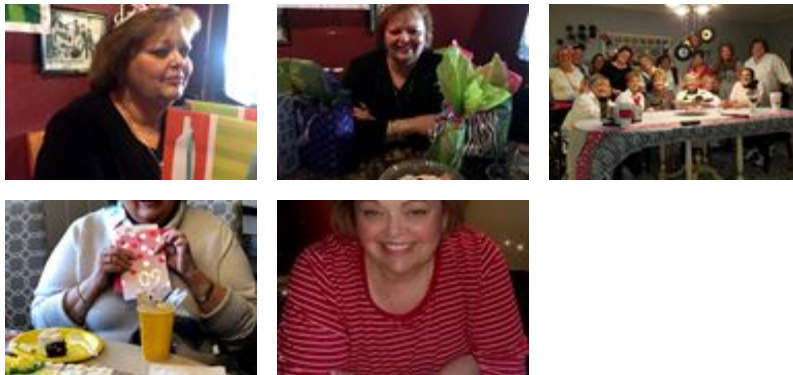
