October 10, 1927 - August 15, 2015

Jim Mae Simpson went to be with our Lord on August 15, 2015. She was born Jim Mae Swann on October 10, 1927 in Newton, Georgia. Her mother, Lenora Swann, died in 1963; her father, James Rufus Swann, died when she was twelve years old. She had one brother, Walter Swann, and two sisters, Carrie Lou Cochran and Mary Ellen Kramer, all of whom preceded her in death. She married John E. Simpson, Jr. in 1948, in Albany, Georgia. She is survived by her husband of 67 years; son, John Simpson, III and his wife, Carolyn, of Lubbock, and daughter Dixie Simpson Cook and her husband, Steve, of Allen, Texas.
