A proud graduate of Cooper High School in 1960, Jimmie went on to serve his country honorably in the United States Air Force, showcasing his commitment to service and dedication. 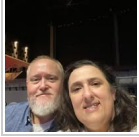

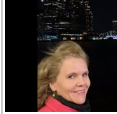

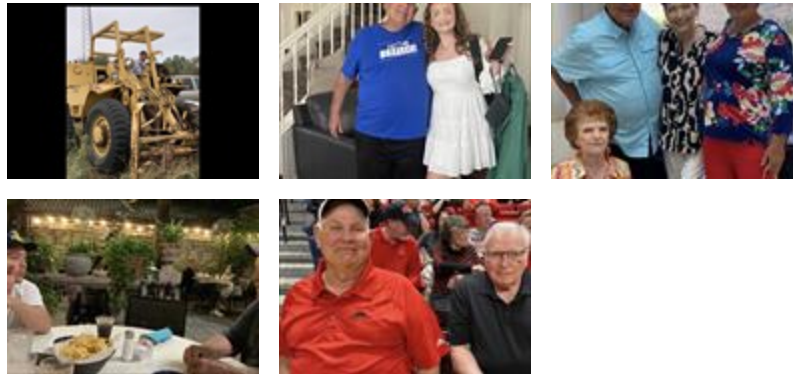
