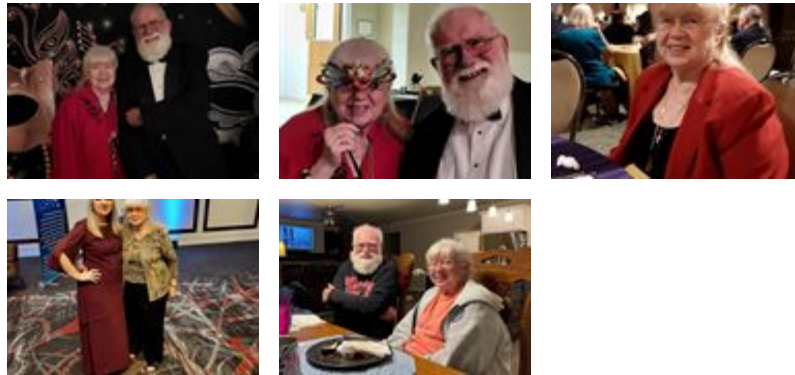

*Aunt Joan, I have two little kiddos up there, please give them a big hug from me, and let them give you the grand tour.*

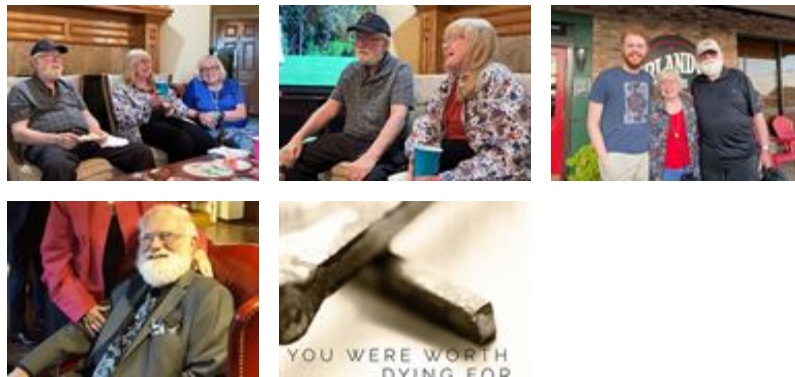
