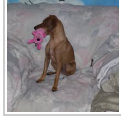

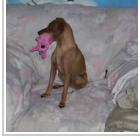

My heart is with you all, always and forever. Love Auntie Teddi

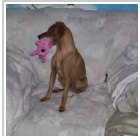

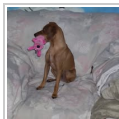
