Dick went to be with the Lord and Savior on Wednesday Dec, 17, 2014 after a valiant battle with cancer. Dick was born June 10, 1942 in Hale Center to Roland and Johnnie Mae Burnett. He moved to Lubbock in the early 1950's where he attended local schools and graduated from Monterey High School in 1960. Dick served in the Army Reserves and retired from Southwestern Bell in 1991 with 25 years' service. Dick married Sylvia Nell Cunningham March 10, 1967. They are both members of Vandelia Church of Christ. Dick was an avid golfer and made many lifelong friends at Rawls Golf Course. He was a blood donor and had reached the Hall of Fame status with United Blood Services of Lubbock.
