John Anna Boyd Dean was born in Lubbock on October 22, 1914 and died in Houston on February 21, 2016. John Anna maintained a strong West Texas spirit throughout her life. Her childhood years were spent on the Hiley T. Boyd family ranch in Whiteface. Later, she attended Texas Tech and in 1938 married Kirk Dean the “cotton man.” John Anna and Kirk lived in Lubbock, raising their children Dianna and John, and in later life moved to Muleshoe. She had deep affection for her nieces, nephews and grandson Kirk. In Lubbock, John Anna served various organizations including the old San Souci social club at Tech and the Canterbury Club at St. Paul’s Episcopal Church. In the 1970’s, she was involved in the grass roots formation of the Ranching Heritage Center and was passionate about her service on the board of the Lubbock Cemetery. In Muleshoe, John Anna shared management of the farm and very proud of her accomplishments with soil conservation.

A graveside service is planned for 12:00, Saturday, February 27, 2016 at the Lubbock Cemetery. If memorials are desired, John Anna requested the Scottish Rite Hospital in Dallas and the Ranching Heritage Center be remembered.
