John H. Putman, MD. passed away March 17, 2021. He was born February 26, 1925 in

Sagerton, Texas, the son of Charles Anderson and Una Granville Putman. He, with family, moved to Lubbock, Texas at the age of 13 years.

After primary schooling, John enlisted in the US Navy. During WWII, while stationed in England, he was injured. He recovered at home sufficiently and enrolled in

Life Bible College in Los Angeles. While studying for the ministry, a friend convinced John to become a medical doctor.

He practiced in Redondo Beach, CA and became the largest single family practitioner in the South Bay area.

On November 3, 1983, after 23 years in practice and because of pain, John retired to his home in Rancho Palos Verdes, CA, where because of his injuries and cancer, he started his walk with God.

John was preceded in death by his parents, 3 brothers, Carl Edwin, Charlie junior, Joe Caradine, 2 sisters, Laura Broadstreet, and Eva Todd.

John is survived by 2 brothers, Douglas Wayne and wife Teresa of Shallowater, TX and Mack Lauderdale and wife Colette of Lubbock, Tx, and long time friend Glen Rogers.
