Anita Joyce Campbell, 86, passed from this life on Sunday, April 26, 2015. Services will be held at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, April 30, 2015 in Sanders Memorial Chapel with the Reverend Richard White officiating. Burial will follow at Resthaven Memorial Park.

Joyce was born January 4, 1929 in Brownfield, TX to Oral and Grace Trotter. Her early years were spent in Wellman, TX until the family moved to Brownfield, TX when Joyce was fourteen. Upon graduation from Brownfield High School, Joyce attended Draughn's Business College in Lubbock, and then began working at Brownfield State Bank. She met and married Robert H. Campbell, a young naval veteran, in 1946. Bob and Joyce moved with their four children from Brownfield to Lubbock in 1963. Joyce continued her banking career at Lubbock National Bank, where she held a vice president position in the installment loan department. Upon her retirement from banking, Joyce continued to be active, working in the real estate business.
