Juanita Landess Gregory, age 88, died at Covenant Medical Center, Lubbock on Wednesday, March 1, 2012. She was born July 10, 1923 in Portales, New Mexico to Margie Woodard and John Felix Landess. In 1929, she and her family moved to Lubbock. Juanita graduated from Lubbock High School in 1941. On June 21, 1941 Juanita married the love of her life, Buford Gregory.
