Juanita Horton was born July 6, 1923 in Sulphur Springs, Texas to Charley Conard and Jesse Watson Lancaster. She attended schools and graduated in 1939 from Goodland High School in Goodland, Texas. Juanita married J. W. Franklin on December 25, 1938. J. W. and Juanita had four children, Ted, Kay, Mike and Terry. After living in various places they settled in O'Donnell, Texas for many years farming. The family moved to Abernathy and later to Lubbock. Juanita worked in the accounting department at Sears for approximately for 20 years. After her husband of 42 years passed away in 1980, she met and married H. T. Horton on November 15, 1983. She continued in her career as supervisor for the accounting department until 1985 when she and H. T. decided it would be more fun to travel and they did for the next 18 years. She was preceded in death by her parents; first husband, J. W. on September 7, 1980, her second husband, H. T. Horton on December 16, 2003; and grandson, Thomas Jay Franklin on May 25, 2011. She was also preceded in death by 6 sisters and 3 brothers. She had the distinction of being the only living Aunt in either the Lancaster or Franklin families. She is survived by 3 sons and a daughter, Ted and wife Frankie, Mike and wife Latane, and Terry and wife Sandie and Kay Franklin Powell and husband Bill. She was also called grandma by 12 grandchildren; and numerous great-great grandchildren; and many nieces, nephews and friends. Juanita was honored with a long and healthy life until she passed on Monday August 28, 2017. She was loved by many but most especially her children and grandchildren. She described as a

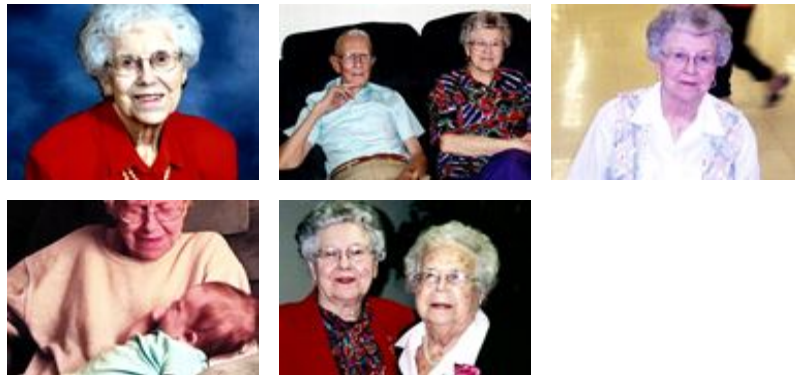
