“ I'm so sorry to hear of Ken's passing. Ken and Linda were members of my parish in Durant, Oklahoma. They were a fixture of the church community when I was growing up. But I really got to know them when they needed some lawn work done, and I needed to earn some money for school. They probably had the most welcoming home I've ever been in. As soon as you stepped in the door, they made you feel like a guest and a friend. And we became good friends and stayed in touch over the last twenty-five years. We always had dinner or breakfast when they came to Dallas. It was a joy to have them visit, but something funny usually happened. The time they parked their RV in the driveway one summer and the breaker tripped in the middle of the night and their AC shut off. Or the time Ken crashed on an air mattress in the living room and woke up to find my kids peeking at him from behind the couch.

I'll always remember Ken's love of reading and walking. If you went to visit, you might end up going on a three-mile jaunt in the evening with a glass of bourbon. We shared quite a few glasses of bourbon over the years while talking about novels. And Linda had such interesting stories about their travels and the people they had met. They both had such spirit for life and an interest in living and learning about the world. They had a wonderful dynamic together. Linda's seriousness and Ken's humor often clashed but they were so dedicated to each other. I went by to see them when Linda was in the hospital in Dallas shortly before her passing. Old age had taken many things from them, but not their devotion to each other. And they carried the torch of their Catholic faith to the end of their lives.

To my mind, the two were inseparable, and, in fact, everyone I knew usually referred to them jointly as Ken and Linda, never just Ken or Linda. After Linda passed, I spoke to Ken a few times on the phone. I know how much he missed her, and sad though I am at his passing, it is good to think of them being together once again.
