Lester Keith White of Lubbock, Texas, passed away in his favorite chair in his home on Wednesday, August 30, 2023. He is now sitting in the lap of his Lord and Savior and is free from all pain and illness. Keith was born on January 11, 1935, in Higgins, Texas; the second of seven children born to Lester "Pop" and Ercil "Mom" White. Keith graduated from Lubbock High School and Texas Tech University. He served his country in the U.S. Marine Corps being honorably discharged with the rank of sergeant.

He married Louella Ann Green on February 6, 1976, and lived in Lubbock for all their 48 years of marriage. Keith and Lou Ann were faithful members of Trinity Church and were both retired from Lubbock ISD. Keith was an avid golfer, faithful friend, and loving family man. Keith suffered a severe case of encephalitis in the late 1960s that affected his vision, balance, and memory capabilities.
