LUBBOCK- Martha Myers McLendon passed away peacefully in her home in Lubbock, Texas on Friday, April 10th, 2015. Born on August 5, 1929 in St. Joseph, Missouri to parents M.B.F. and Hazel Meyers, Martha grew up in Ft. Worth, Texas and graduated from Paschal High School. While attending Texas Tech she married James Thomas Dennison and gave birth to 3 beautiful children. In later years she married Donald Robertson who preceded her in death. In 1978 she married Donald Alvin McLendon of Post, Texas, and began an exciting new life supporting his farming and ranching operation. They enjoyed life together for 22 years until his death in 2000.

Martha was a good Christian woman. She loved her family and also being with friends. She was a member of the Samaritans Sunday school class at First Baptist Church in Lubbock, and was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Post, Texas. She was also a member of the Lubbock Women's Club, Knife and Fork Dinner Club and the Second Thursday Bridge Group.
