Mary Louise Culpepper Wilder, formerly of Lakeland, FL, died on January 24, 2011 in Lubbock, TX. She was born in Miami on June 21, 1925 and lived in Florida until moving to Lubbock in April 2008. Louise was married to her husband, Glen G. Wilder, Jr., for 64 years, and they worked together for more than 40 years in their business, Glen's Outboard, in Lakeland, FL, where she kept the financial records.
