LUBBOCK — Odell Lee Lowe of Lubbock passed away Tuesday, November 25, bringing to a close 92 years of a fruitful life on earth. Mr. Lowe was preceded in death by his wife, Nell Graham Lowe, whom he dearly loved and was married to for 67 years before she passed away in 2011.

Mr. Lowe was born Dec. 9, 1922, in Lovington, New Mexico. He was a loving, supportive and encouraging husband, father and grandfather. Through his work as a cattle rancher for more than 70 years in West Texas, Mr. Lowe built an outstanding reputation as both a producer of the highest quality of livestock and an innovator. He has been credited with bringing the Limousine breed of cattle to Texas. A quiet philanthropist, Mr. Lowe was a faithful member of First Baptist Lubbock and Downtown Bible Class and contributed to Texas Tech Athletics' beef scholarship program for more than 40 years.

Mr. Lowe is survived by his daughter, Shana Lowe Conine; grandchildren, Kelly Lowe Read and Chad Read, Lauren Lowe Matthews and Ryan Matthews, Chad Conine, Chaney Conine Cockrell and Ian Cockrell, Haley Lowe Erdlen and Andrew Erdlen, and Calley Conine Durant and Wesley Durant; and great-grandchildren, Avery and Hunter Read, Madison, Hayden and Marlowe Matthews, Eli and Evan Cockrell, Ivy and Fiona Erdlen and Reagan Durant.

He is preceded in death by his mother and father, Nettie and H.L. Lowe; his son, Daryl Lowe; his brothers, Howard, Brady and Coy; and sister, Vora Lowe Hartley.
