Patsy Joyce Hufstedler Holt was born January 4, 1935 in Plainview, TX to E.K. Hufstedler, Jr. and Alice Estelle Moore Hufstedler. She passed away in Lubbock, TX on October 21, 2020 at the age of 85. Her family moved to Lubbock when she was 5 years old. She graduated from Lubbock High School in 1953. She attended Abilene Christian College where she met Wayne Holt on a blind date. They married on October 8, 1955 at Broadway Church of Christ in Lubbock. She was a lifetime member of the Church of Christ, teaching Sunday school and later serving on the benevolence committee. Patsy and Wayne moved to Austin, TX in 1996, where they lived for 17 years before moving back to Lubbock in 2013. She was preceded in death by her husband, Wayne, in 2015 and by her parents. She is survived by her sons: Richard and wife Kathy of Dallas, TX; Mark and wife Brenda of Buda, TX; Mike and wife Katie of Belton, TX; and Ragan and wife Cherie of Lubbock; 10 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her brother and sisters: Don Hufstedler, Sue Conder, and Linda Mack and husband Scott, all of Lubbock.
