She graduated from West Texas State University and later earned two masters degrees. She began teaching at Lubbock High School in 1959. She taught in Guthrie, Hereford, and Seagraves before retiring as the 4-County Special Education Co-op Supervisor in Brownfield.

As a fun part-time job, and after retiring from education, Pat worked as a travel agent for Envoyè Travel. Bob and Pat enjoyed traveling the world, visiting every continent except Antarctica. Nothing made them happier than when their grandchildren began traveling with them.

She will be remembered as a loving wife, amazing mother, wonderful grandmother, beloved sister, competitive bridge player, loyal friend, and a devoted member of First Christian Church of Lubbock.

Her last act of servanthood was knitting 454 hats as Christmas gifts for the students of Lubbock ISD Bean Elementary.
