Our beloved Mother and Mamaw went to be with her Lord on October 28, 2017, at the age of 95. Pauline was preceded in death by her husband Daulton in 2011, their infant son Ronnie in 1947, an infant grand-daughter and her brother Louis. Pauline was born to Abraham and Mary Farr on October 17, 1922, in Gainesville, Texas. In 1928, the family moved to West Texas, and began farming in Lamb County. Pauline attended grade school in Hart Camp and Spade, where she met her future husband, Daulton, who was attending Fieldton High. She graduated from Spade in 1939 and attended Wayland College for one year. She and Daulton married in 1941 and one week later, World War 2 began. Daulton joined the Air Force & served in the China, Burma and India Theatre. After the war, they moved to Lubbock, started a family, and joined First Baptist Church where Pauline taught children's Sunday School for 56 years.

Our Mom was an accomplished seamstress and enjoyed a 50-year sewing business out of our home. She loved to cook, garden, play the piano, and write poetry and music. Her home-grown tomatoes, pecans and homemade relish were famous. She loved to entertain and sit on the front porch with Daddy and visit with neighbors. She was a homemaker in every sense of the word and established many sweet family traditions that remain to this day. Her real passion was studying and applying God's word and sharing the love of Jesus

With everyone she met.

Pauline's children are son Danny and Monica of Allen; daughter Darlene and Ron of Frisco; daughter Denise and Tom of Odessa; and son Dale and Cheryl of Lubbock.
