June 17, 1921 - February 11, 2023

Pauline Garrett Brock, 101, of Lubbock, Texas, passed away February 11, 2023.

Pauline was born on June 17, 1921 in Gholson, Texas to James Garrett and Dora Effie Kidd Garrett. Their family farmed, gardened, raised chickens, and kept milk cows. Pauline learned to sew at a young age and loved designing dresses from flour sack fabric. She grew up to become an accomplished seamstress and designer. During WWII, Pauline worked for Consolidated Air, laying out radio circuit boards. After the war, she studied at the National School of Dress Design in Chicago, did postgraduate work in millinery and dress design at the Vogue School, and left there to become a draper and finisher in Blum's Vogue Custom Designing House. She later returned to Texas to teach sewing. In Lubbock, she met Ralph Brock, a lawyer. She came to see him for legal advice on a probate, and Ralph was charmed by Pauline and her sense of style. They married on June 27th, 1948 and celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary together before Ralph's passing. Pauline was proud to earn her bachelor's degree in Applied Arts from Texas Tech in 1959. She then pursued a 20+ year teaching career, teaching Kindergarten and 2nd grade.

Her family includes son Steven Ralph Brock and daughter-in-law Susan Lorsch, daughter Elaine Garrett Brock, grandchildren Jeremy Brock and his

wife Amy Brock, Benjamin Brock, David Glasheen and his wife Mary Glasheen, Katharine Glasheen, and Paul Glasheen, and five great-grandchildren.

Pauline is preceded in death by husband Ralph Brock, father James Garrett, mother Dora Garrett, and half-sisters Ruth McRae and Lucille Stowers.
