Peggy Joyce Ballard was born May 13, 1934 in Lubbock County. She was preceded in death by her father, Benjamin Denton; mother, Mabel Denton; sister, Bennie Lou Travis; husband, Ulysses Grant Ballard; and grandson, Justin Ballard.

Peggy and Ulas Grant Ballard were married June 29, 1957. They had two sons, Rickey Grant and wife, Deborah of Terrell, TX, and Danny Wayne of Lubbock, TX.

Ulas passed away in 1998 and grandson, Justin passed away this year, 2013. Peggy is also survived by three grandsons, Jonathan Andrew, Jacob Matthew, and Joshua Benjamin; and a great granddaughter, Skylar Anne, all of the Dallas area. Peggy has a sister, Barbara Roberts and husband, Bill of Lubbock; and a brother, Jerry Denton and wife, Sherry of Lubbock. She also has several nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Peggy was saved at the age of 13 at The First Baptist Church in Wolfforth, TX. She graduated from Frenship High School. Peggy moved to Lubbock and worked for ten years at J.C. Pennys. It was during this time the Peggy and Ulas were married in the First Baptist Church in Wolfforth.

She also worked for the Southwest Lighthouse for the Blind, making camouflage helmet covers on the sewing machine for the soldiers in the Desert Storm War for three years.

Peggy joined Insight Group for the Blind where they shared their experiences with each other. She was also elected President, and served for five years.

In 1995, Peggy moved her church membership from First Baptist Church in Wolfforth to Redbud Baptist Church in Lubbock. Peggy loved her church and attended Sunday School and Worship as often as she could.

Funeral services will be at 1:00 p.m., Thursday, May 2, 2013 at Redbud Baptist Church. Interment will follow at the City of Lubbock Cemetery under the direction of Sanders Funeral Home.
